1 Title

- (1) These regulations are the Land Transport (Offences and Penalties) Amendment Regulations 2000.
- (2) In these regulations, the Land Transport (Offences and Penalties) Regulations 1999¹ are called "the principal regulations".

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 25 January 2001, replace Schedule 1 in the Land Transport (Offences and Penalties) Regulations 1999 with a *new Schedule 1*. The *new Schedule 1* augments the previous Schedule 1 by specifying infringement fees for breaches of various provisions in the following Land Transport Rules:
