# **Immigration Amendment Regulations (No 3) 2005**

Immigration Amendment Regulations (No 3) 2005: revoked, at 2 am on 29 November 2010, pursuant to section 405(b) of the Immigration Act 2009 (2009 No 51).

Pursuant to section 150 of the Immigration Act 1987, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting on the advice and with the consent of the Executive Council, makes the following regulations.

#### 1 Title

(1) These regulations are the Immigration Amendment Regulations (No 3) 2005.

#### Note

(2) In these regulations, the Immigration Regulations 1999<sup>1</sup> are called "the principal regulations".

#### 2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

#### 3 Schedule 1 amended

Part 1 of Schedule 1 of the principal regulations is amended by omitting from clause B.1(b)(ii) the item "Israel (other than persons travelling to New Zealand in any official Israeli Government capacity)", and substituting the item "Israel".

# **Explanatory note**

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the Immigration Regulations 1999 to restore the visa-free status of citizens of Israel travelling to New Zealand in an official government capacity, with effect on and after the day following the Date of notification of the regulations in the *Gazette*.
