

# **Maritime Transport (Infringement Fees for Offences Relating to Major Maritime Events) Amendment Regulations 2006**

## **Preamble**

At Wellington this 28th day of August 2006

Pursuant to sections 201 and 423 of the Maritime Transport Act 1994, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting on the advice and with the consent of the Executive Council, makes the following regulations.

### **1 Title**

These regulations are the Maritime Transport (Infringement Fees for Offences Relating to Major Maritime Events) Amendment Regulations 2006.

### **2 Commencement**

These regulations come into force on 10 October 2006.

**3 Principal regulations amended**

These regulations amend the Maritime Transport (Infringement Fees for Offences Relating to Major Maritime Events) Regulations 1999.

**4 Infringement notices**

Regulation 4 is amended by inserting “under section 423 of the Act” after “Every infringement notice”.

**5 Schedule amended**

The infringement notice in the Schedule is amended—

- (a) by omitting “Name:” and substituting “Full name:” ;  
and
- (b) by omitting “Address:” and substituting “Full address:”.

These regulations clarify name and address requirements in the infringement notice prescribed by, and correct a drafting error in, the Maritime Transport (Infringement Fees for Offences Relating to Major Maritime Events) Regulations 1999.
