1 Title

These regulations are the Maritime Transport (Infringement Fees for Offences Relating to Major Maritime Events) Amendment Regulations 2006.

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 10 October 2006.

4 Infringement notices

Regulation 4 is amended by inserting "under section 423 of the Act" after "Every infringement notice".

5 Schedule amended

The infringement notice in the Schedule is amended—

- (a) by omitting "Name:" and substituting "Full name:";
- (b) by omitting "Address:" and substituting "Full address:".
