Pursuant to section 6 of the Wildlife Act 1953, the Minister of Conservation gives the following notice.

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New item inserted in Schedule 1

This notice is the Grey-Faced Petrel (Northern Muttonbird) Amendment Notice 2009.
- 2 Commencement**
This notice comes into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.
- 3 Principal notice amended**
This notice amends the Grey-Faced Petrel (Northern Muttonbird) Notice 1979.

“(ea) Moutohorā (also known as Whale Island):”.

Schedule 1 is amended by inserting the item set out in the Schedule of this notice after the item relating to Rawhiti Maori Executive.

- add Moutohorā (also known as Whale Island) to the list of islands in clause 6(1) for which permits authorising the hunting or killing of grey-faced petrels (northern muttonbirds) may be issued; and

- include Te Tapatoru ā Toi as a committee that may issue permits authorising the hunting or killing of grey-faced petrels on Moutohorā.
