## Regulations

#### 1 Title

These regulations are the Fisheries (Amateur Fishing) Amendment Regulations 2021.

#### 2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 1 December 2021.

#### 3 Principal regulations

These regulations amend the Fisheries (Amateur Fishing) Regulations 2013.

#### 4 Schedule 10A amended

In Schedule 10A, replace the items relating to ordinary paua and yellowfoot paua with:

Ordinary paua	5
Yellowfoot paua	5

### **Explanatory note**

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect. These regulations reduce from 6 to 5 the daily limit for ordinary paua and yellowfoot paua in Te Whata Kai o Rakihouia i Te Tai o Marokura—Kaikōura Marine Area. These regulations come into force on 1 December 2021.
